
Being the densest capital in Brazil, our city is the 5th most populous in the country, with 2.7 million people and approximately 315 km<sup>2</sup> of extension. Fortaleza is the only capital located within the Brazilian semi-arid region. which is marked by long periods of drought, erratic rainfall and strong winds. Scarcity was the constituent element of culture and economy for many centuries. From such element emerged a creative, innovative, versatile and enterprising civilization. Fortaleza has become a laboratory for inclusive public policies in Brazil centered on people and with a strong appeal to the respect and the promotion of human rights, especially for the most vulnerable groups. We seek to leave no one and no place behind.

Located in the corner of the Atlantic Ocean, Fortaleza has a strategic position that puts us as one of the most vibrant centers of connections the world. We technological, maritime and air hubs. There are 16 fiber-optic submarine cables in operation connecting Brazil with Africa, Europe, North America, Central America and South America. Fortaleza has direct international flights daily to locations such as Amsterdam, Madrid, Lisbon, Frankfurt, Miami, Buenos Aires Orlando, besides connections to all major airports in Brazil.

Fortaleza has a federal seaport - Mucuripe - with great movement of cargo and passengers, and 48 km from Fortaleza is located the Pecém Industrial and Seaport Complex, belonging to the Government of the State of Ceará. These two seaports have an impact on the development of all Metropolitan Region, as well as create a commercial warehouse of international scope.

It is time to turn the Forum back to Latin America, which plays an important role in the forefront of the development of innovative policies, urban with special attention given to the right to the city. This region is one step ahead in facing the world's major urban issues, considering that the global forecast of 70% of people living in cities until 2050 has already become a reality in this region since 2018, as 80% of its people currently live in cities.

Fortaleza aims to host the 13th edition of the WUF in 2026 because it innovates and offers visitors and residents alike a series of projects based on the concept of local action for global impacts. The city seeks to connect internationally through various partnerships, technical cooperation agreements, forums, global commitments and

international campaigns to establish political dialogue and to share its interventions.

embraces Fortaleza several global agreements to which Brazil is signatory, such as the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction and the Paris Climate Accords, and implemented these policies in its Participative Strategic Plan and in its long-term planning (Plano Fortaleza 2040), a new way of city planning focused on citizens that aims to reduce social, economic and spatial inequalities. Municipality of Fortaleza committed to making our city inclusive, safe, resilient sustainable, in order to ensure has everyone access to adequate housing and affordable pricing according to the 2030 Agenda of the United Nations.

### The trajectory of Fortaleza

In recent years, we have shared the dream of living in a more equal, more just and safer society, with decent work and education. We recognize and vehemently defend the right to freedom and the respect to cultural, biological, ethnic, linguistic and religious diversity. We plan our projects and actions together because then we define exactly where we want to go and where we want to arrive at. In 2020, Fortaleza reached the World Health Organization goal of reducing traffic accidents, reducing, in the last 10 years, 51.7% of traffic related deaths, accounting 7.2 deaths per 100,000 inhabitants. In 2010, Fortaleza had 14.9 deaths per 100,000 inhabitants. In relation to the reduction of CO2 emissions, we are committed to RACE TO ZERO, and the speedy increase with which our bike lane network, in 9 years, has gone from 63 km (2013) to 410 km (2022), is testament to that.

The city of Fortaleza develops disruptive initiatives such as Desigual Lab, the city's laboratory for innovation in order to accelerate the reduction of socioeconomic and territorial inequalities. Affirmative actions, such as gender policies and policies to end racism, are transversal in the municipal agenda, as well as the perspective of early childhood in city planning. For innovative and effective governance in accelerating the city's development and reduction of inequalities, Fortaleza possesses human capital prepared to use new information and data science methods and technologies (big data, data analytics, artificial intelligence, machine learning, data science).


